


Amendment to the JPF Bylaws

- An amendment to the JPF Bylaws has been proposed and approved by the JPF Board of Directors. The amendment would extend the western Membership Boundary from Austin Avenue to Nagle Avenue.
- A Bylaws Amendment is approved by a two-thirds vote of all eligible Regular Members present at the Annual Meeting if a Membership Quorum exists at the meeting.
