1. Welcome

Ryan Richter, JPF President, kicked off the meeting and welcomed the group. Notable was the fact that all who attended except for our guest speaker and 1 other were all paid members of JPF. Jessica Smith, owner of Anemone Creative added her welcome and spoke about the space with her hope that the floral design studio will become "a neighborhood place for artistic thinkers." The building has been owned by her great aunt for the past 50 years and she is looking to reinvent the former office space.

2. Guest Speaker: Jane Grover, Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning

This was the second time Jane Grover had spoken at a JPF meeting, introducing the mission of CMAP at our general meeting last June. Tonight she conducted an interactive survey as part of the 2050 comprehensive regional plan asking the group for what they saw as priorities concerning five possible futures:

- Changed Climate
- Walkable Communities
- Innovative Transportation
- Transformed Economy
- Constrained Resources
