 - Incorporation
 - Tax-exempt status application





Treasurer's Update

- On-going Expenses
 - Website hosting/maintenance: ~\$300/year
 - Sponsorships: varies
 - This year, we sponsored the JP Farmer's Market
 - Future sponsorships: ArtsALIVE, public sculptures, people spaces
 - General materials: ~\$100
 - Annual incorporation fees: \$50
 - Local livability initiatives (planting, cleanup, etc.): ~\$300
- Stretch goals:
 - Participation in urban planning workshops
 - Larger projects


